RE: Crystalline Silicon Photovoltaic Cells, Whether or Not Assembled Into Modules, from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam: Quantity and Value Questionnaire Response Extension

To All Interested Parties:

This letter concerns the antidumping duty investigation of crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells, whether or not assembled into modules, from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam. On May 22, 2024, we received a letter from JA Solar USA Inc. and JA Solar Vietnam Company Limited (collectively, JA Solar) requesting a 14-day extension until June 18, 2024, to respond to the quantity and value questionnaire. Responses to the quantity and value questionnaire are currently due on June 4, 2024.<sup>1</sup>

After consideration of the reasons in the request, we are granting all interested parties a two-day extension to submit responses to the quantity and value questionnaire. Accordingly, responses to the quantity and value questionnaire for **all interested parties** are now due **no later than 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on June 6, 2024.**
